GETTING HERE

BY SUBWAY / TRAIN

The nearest travel link is Partick Interchange - while you're there, on Merkland Court you'll see three gable-end murals which were created in 2022 as part of the Yardworks GRID Programme.

From there it's a 10 minute walk to SWG3 along the Expressway. This route also passes the painted railway arches at SWG3, which are regularly painted by local graffiti artists throughout the year.




GETTING HERE

BY BIKE

There are cycle racks and Nextbike stands on Kelvinhaugh Street. As the festival site gets very busy, we can't allow bikes in, so please park up before coming in.

BY CAR

As the streets around the festival site will be busy, we highly recommend using public transport where possible. If you are driving, the nearest car park is at Riverside Museum, and from there it's a 10 minute walk along the Expressway.



COLLECTING YOUR TICKETS

Our Box Office is located on Eastvale Place next to the new Yardworks Studio. When you arrive, if you need to **buy tickets** or **pick up guest tickets**, please go to the Box Office. Tickets can also be bought online throughout the festival.

FAMILIES

If you haven't booked in advance, there may still be spaces available, so we recommend turning up and asking. All other activities are all included within your Yardworks ticket.

The site is wheelchair accessible, with accessible toilets in the Yardworks Studio and Acid Bar, and a lift to the Warehouse and Terrace. The Galvanisers Yard is an outdoors space, so please note that some of the ground may be uneven. If you need assistance at any point, please speak to a member of staff.


